## **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity**

Grant us Your faith, Your forgiveness, Your gift of reconciliation so that we may be one as You are One, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

#### Pentecost

Come Holy Spirit, burn in our hearts, that we may know the truth of faith in God through Christ.
